Upon reviewing your final brief of appellant filed August 8, 2026, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- Your final brief must be identical to your initial brief filed on October 24, 2025, and accepted by this Court by order dated December 9, 2025. *See* Rule 211(c), SCACR.
- The document is not paginated. Your final brief must be paginated.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the cover of the final brief should have your contact information listed.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR, showing you served counsel Respondent with a copy of the final brief by US mail or hand-delivery.
- Your final brief may not include exhibits.
- Your final brief is not in the correct format. The final brief should be in the format listed in Rule 211, SCACR.

Additionally, the amended record on appeal was due to be served and filed by August 7, 2026. As of today's date, we have not received your record on appeal.

Failure to correct the above deficiencies, and file the amended record on appeal, will result in the dismissal of the appeal.
