Randall Gene Posey with the Court of Appeals on July 6, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of The State v. Timothy James Thompson with the Supreme Court on June 29, 2026. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Jimmie McMillan with the Court of Appeals on June 15, 2026. Counsel filed the Reply to Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Jharaun Washington with the Supreme Court on June 12, 2026. 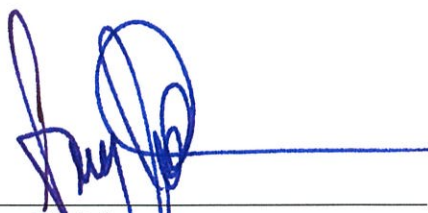

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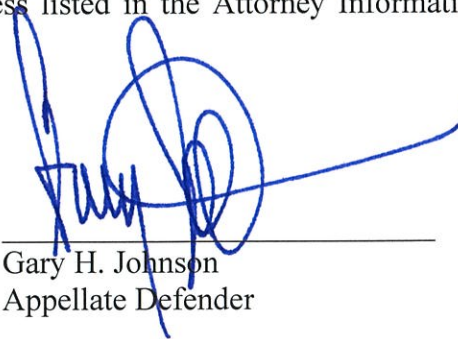
