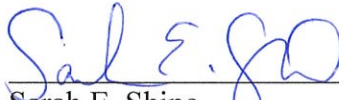

Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Robert Tyrwick Hoffman with the Court of Appeals on July 9, 2026. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of David R. Dozier v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 9, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Measha Jaquetta Shawnic Joyner with the Court of Appeals on July 2, 2026. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Kasiem Rashawn Stephens with the Court of Appeals on June 26, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals and Appendix in the case of Anthony Briggs v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 19, 2026. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Ralph Jake Goss, Jr. v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 10, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Jose R. Reyes v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 5, 2026.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

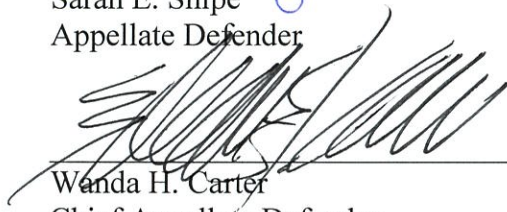

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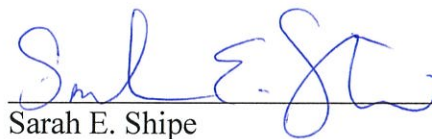
