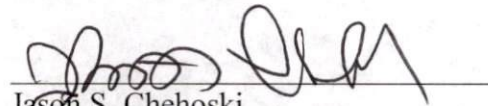

Trafficking in Methamphetamine or Cocaine Base

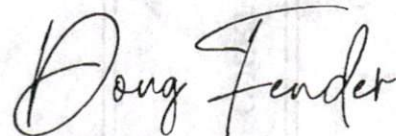
§44-53-375(C)(2)(a)

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on November 20, 2025, the Grand Jurors of Edgefield County present upon their oath:

Trafficking in Methamphetamine or Cocaine Base

That in Edgefield County, South Carolina, on or about **March 15, 2025**, the Defendant, **Tracy Alice Rel**, did knowingly sell, manufacture, deliver, purchase, or otherwise bring into this State, or provide financial assistance or otherwise aid, abet, attempt, or conspire to sell, manufacture, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State, or was knowingly in actual or constructive possession of more than twenty-eight grams but less than one hundred grams of methamphetamine or cocaine base as defined and otherwise limited in Section 44-53-110, 44-53-210(d)(1) or 44-53-210(d)(2), to wit: a clear bag containing methamphetamine and clear capsules containing methamphetamine, all in violation of Section 44-53-375(C)(2)(a), *et al.*, of the Code of Laws of South Carolina.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
