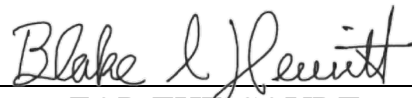

ORDER

On July 1, 2026, Appellant's counsel, an attorney with the Office of Appellate Defense, a division of the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense (SCCID), filed a motion for the appointment of outside counsel because representing Appellant on appeal may require the Office of Appellate Defense to take a position contrary to a position previously taken by SCCID, which would be a conflict of interest. After careful consideration, the motion for the appointment of outside counsel is granted. Due to the potential conflict of interest, this court requests the Clerk of Court for Spartanburg County to immediately appoint the next lawyer on the appointment list to represent Appellant on appeal. *See* Rule 608, SCACR. Upon receiving notice of the appointment, counsel shall immediately file a notice of appearance with this court.
