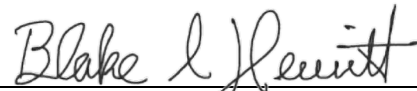

ORDER

On June 29, 2026, Respondent filed a motion to dismiss, arguing Appellant failed to timely serve and file his initial brief and designation of matter.
