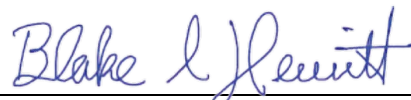

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## ORDER

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On June 29, 2026, Appellant filed a motion to strike several items designated by Respondent. On July 20, 2026, Respondent filed a return, agreeing to portions of the motion to strike and opposing other portions. After careful consideration, we grant the motion to strike in part and deny in part. Appellant's motion to strike the SCDC Policy/Procedure OP-22.06 and Post Order 6 is denied. However, Appellant's motion to strike portions of depositions is granted. Within ten days from the date of this order, Respondent shall serve and file an amended designation of matter striking matter 14 except as to pages 19-20, 29-30, and 60; matter 15 except as to pages 141-42 and 146; matter 16 except as to pages 16-17, 19, and 20-22; matter 17 except as to pages 21 and 40; matter 20 except as to page 8; matter 22 except as to pages 23-24 and 110; and matter 23 except as to pages 12-13 and 15.
