**MOTION FOR 60-DAY EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF ON BEHALF OF
RESPONDENT ANDREW ROSS CLARK**

Respondent Andrew Ross Clark, by and through undersigned counsel, respectfully move the Court for a 60-day extension of time to file the Initial Brief on behalf of Respondent Andrew Ross Clark.

This motion is made pursuant to South Carolina Appellate Court Rules 240 and 263. Rule 240 governs motions for extensions of time. Rule 263 authorizes this Court to extend the time for any act other than for service of the notice of appeal.

In support of the requested relief, Respondent Andrew Ross Clark states the following:

1. Respondent Andrew Ross Clark was served with Appellants' Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal via electronic mail on July 30, 2026.

2. Pursuant to Rule 208 and Rule 263 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Respondent Andrew Ross Clark's Initial Brief is currently due on August 31, 2026.

3. Respondent Andrew Ross Clark seeks a 60-day extension up to and including October 30, 2026, to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal.

4. Appellants' Initial Brief was originally due on May 31, 2026. However, counsel for Appellants requested a 60-day extension. Counsel for Respondent Andrew Ross Clark consented to the extension via electronic mail on May 7, 2026, and counsel for Appellants stated they would consent to a similar extension for Respondents.

5. This Court granted Appellants' Amended Motion for 60-Day Extension of Time to File Initial Brief on July 14, 2026. Appellants' Amended Motion for 60-Day Extension of Time referenced Appellants' consent to a similar request for an extension of time to be filed on behalf of Respondents. *See* Appellants' Mot. for Extension of Time at 2, ¶ 7.

6. Appellants filed and served their Initial Brief and Designation of Matter on July 30, 2026.

7. On August 12, 2016, this Court similarly granted an extension of time for Respondents Uber Technologies, Inc. and Rasier LLC to file their initial brief and designation of matter until October 30, 2026.

8. Respondent Andrew Ross Clark seeks a similar extension of time to file his Initial Brief, which would make the deadline to file his Initial Brief the same as the deadline for Respondents Uber Technologies, Inc. and Rasier LLC.

9. Appellants confirmed their consent regarding Respondent Andrew Ross Clark's requested 60-day extension via electronic mail on August 14, 2026.

10. This is the first request on behalf of Respondent Andrew Ross Clark for an extension

of the Initial Brief deadline.

11. The requested extension will not prejudice Appellants and is sought in good faith to ensure the issues are fully and properly presented for the Court's consideration.

WHEREFORE, Respondent Andrew Ross Clark respectfully requests that the Court grant a 60-day extension of time, up to and including October 30, 2026, for filing Respondent Andrew Ross Clark's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal.
