COUNT ONE
MURDER

That, the Defendant, Sha'Qua Dyrelle-Ameik Hickman-Mickens did in Lee County, on or about July 24, 2024, willfully, feloniously, and intentionally kill the victim, Kelvin Stinney, with malice aforethought, either express or implied, by means of a firearm, and the victim did die as a proximate result thereof on or about in Lee County, in violation of Section 16-03-0010, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT TWO
ARMED ROBBERY

That on or about July 24, 2024, in Lee County, South Carolina, the Defendant, Sha'Qua Dyrelle-Ameik Hickman-Mickens, at Lightwood Knot Road in the County of Lee, by use of force, threats or intimidation and while armed with a deadly weapon, or while alleging, either by action or words, he was armed while using a representation of a deadly weapon or other object which a person present during the commission of the robbery reasonably believed to be a deadly weapon, did take and carry away goods and/or monies from the person or immediate presence of Kelvin Stinney with the intent to permanently deprive the victim of possession thereof, in violation of Section 16-11-330(A) of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.
