**APPELLANT'S NOTICE OF PENDING EMERGENCY MOTIONS, NON-WAIVER, AND
RESERVATION OF CONSTITUTIONAL AND FEDERAL ADA RIGHTS**

Appellant Olga Teslenko, Pro Se, respectfully provides formal notice to the Court of Appeals regarding the procedural status of Appellate Case No. 2024-001734:

1. **Pending Emergency Motion:** On August 10, 2026, Appellant filed her Protective Motion for Emergency Stay, Clarification Nunc Pro Tunc, and Reasonable ADA Accommodation, requesting an immediate stay of the August 20, 2026 briefing deadline, clarification of the court's November 26, 2025 threshold Order, and a 60-day reasonable accommodation under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. § 12101 et seq.) following rulings on the previous two requests.

2. **Pending Supreme Court Mandamus:** Appellant's Verified Petition for Writ of Mandamus (Event Case No. 2026-001758) remains pending before the Supreme Court of South Carolina, challenging administrative actions that impact the integrity and completeness of the appellate record, effectively terminate the underlying appeal and deny constitutional rights.

3. **Express Non-Waiver & Spoliation Objection:** Filing a Record on Appeal that omits authenticated trial evidence submitted below—while threshold jurisdictional and evidence transmission pleadings remain unruléd upon—would force a constructive spoliation of the trial record and result in a forfeiture of Appellant's Constitutional rights without due process. Appellant maintains that proceeding on an incomplete record devoid of her trial evidence would result in irreparable prejudice and constructive spoliation, and she submits this Notice to preserve her due process rights without waiving her objections while her threshold motions remain pending.

4. **Formal Reservation of Federal Rights:** Appellant stands on her pending August 10, 2026 Protective Motion and expressly preserves all rights under:

- a. Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. § 12101 et seq.);
- b. The Due Process and Equal Protection Clauses of the Fourteenth Amendment to the United States Constitution; and
- c. Article I, §§ 3 and 9 of the South Carolina Constitution.

Appellant respectfully awaits the Court's judicial rulings on her pending Protective Motion.
