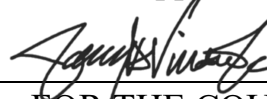

ORDER

Appellant filed a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. No return was filed. The right to proceed *in forma pauperis* must rest upon a statute or a fundamental constitutional right. *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). Appellant has the burden of showing he is entitled to this relief, but he has not done so. Accordingly, after careful consideration, Appellant's motion is denied. The filing fee must be paid within fifteen (15) days of the date of this order. Failure to provide the filing fee will result in dismissal of the appeal.
