I am filing this emergency petition because I am facing imminent physical ejectment from my primary residence by the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office as early as tomorrow morning (Tuesday, August 18, 2026).

Because of the extreme time sensitivity, I respectfully request that this filing packet be routed immediately to the duty judge for consideration of a Temporary Administrative Stay under Rule 241(e) to halt the physical eviction while the court reviews the petition.
