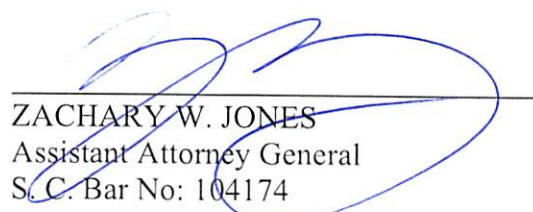
III.
