As you know, your attempt to appeal directly from the Board of Probation, Parole, and Pardon Services was dismissed by order dated December 19, 2013. This order specifically noted that "no statutory provision authorizes an appeal to be taken directly from the Board to either this Court or the South Carolina Court of Appeals."

The Court of Appeals has now forwarded to this Court a second notice of appeal that you have filed seeking to directly appeal the Board's decision to the Court of Appeals. This notice of appeal is dated December 27, 2013. In light of this Court's prior order reference above and the fact that there is no provision of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules that allows the filing of a second notice of appeal from the same order of a lower court or tribunal, no action will be taken on this

second notice of appeal.
