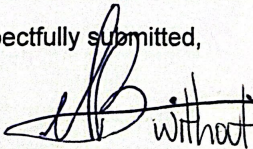

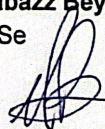

MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM APPELLATE FILING FEE AND TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

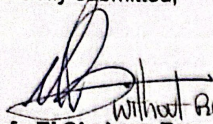

In support of this Motion, Appellant states as follows:

1. Appellant is appealing the August 20, 2026 Order of Dismissal entered by the South Carolina Administrative Law Court in Docket No. 25-ALJ-18-0423-AP.

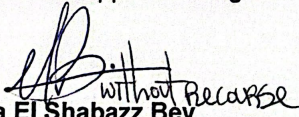

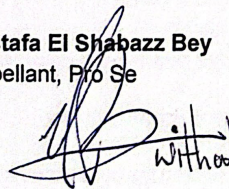
