ORDER

Appellant filed a notice of appeal from a circuit court order finding the lower court lacked jurisdiction to consider the matter as the case was previously dismissed and the time had run to file a Rule 59(e), SCRCP motion. Appellant filed an "emergency motion to vacate judgments." After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's emergency motion to vacate judgments.

Appellant also moved to proceed *in forma pauperis*. The right to proceed *in forma pauperis* must rest upon a statute or a fundamental constitutional right. *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). Appellant has the burden of showing her entitlement to this relief, but she has not done so. Therefore, Appellant's motion is denied. The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order. Failure to provide the filing fee may result in dismissal of the appeal.
