**ORDER AND NOTICE OF HEARING
ON MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF
TIME TO RESPOND TO COMPLAINT**

THIS MATTER is before the Court upon a Complaint filed July 20, 2026.¹ The Court's records indicate issuance of a Summons,² but the record does not include any evidence of timely service of the Summons and Complaint as required by Fed. R. Bank. P. 7004. *See also* Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(l). On August 21, 2026, Defendant filed a Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to Complaint (the "Motion"),³ seeking an extension of thirty days to file a response to the Complaint. Although Defendant did not raise an issue with service, such issue could still be raised in a responsive pleading or by motion. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b).⁴ For purposes of efficiency and to avoid any delay in the

future, Plaintiffs shall submit for filing **within ten (10) days of this Order** one of the following: (a) proof of timely service with an affidavit as required by Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(l) verifying that service was made in compliance with the requirements of Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004, (b) a document signed by Defendant either waiving or accepting service, or (c) a request for reissuance of the Summons, if necessary. To the extent that Plaintiffs wish to file a response or objection to the relief sought in the Motion, they may also do so by September 10, 2026.

The Court will hold a hearing to address the service issues set forth herein as well as the relief sought in the Motion on **September 22, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Clement F. Haynsworth Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse, 300 East Washington Street, Greenville, SC 29601

The parties shall consult at their earliest convenience before the hearing and make a good faith effort to propose a consensual order addressing the issues raised herein. To the extent a proposed consent order is submitted and is entered by the Court before September 15, 2026, the matter may be removed from the calendar.

Absent further order of the Court cancelling the hearing, failure to appear at the hearing as scheduled pursuant to this Order may result in adverse action being taken by the Court against the party failing to appear, including potential dismissal of the Adversary Proceeding or denial of the relief sought in the Motion, without further notice or a hearing.

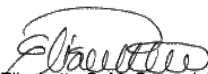
