**RETURN TO MOTION TO STRIKE PORTIONS OF THE
DESIGNATION OF MATTER TO BE INCLUDED IN THE RECORD ON
APPEAL**

The Appellant timely files her reply, given the return was filed on August 25, 2026 and the 5th day was Sunday.

The Respondent's Return to the Motion to Strike portions of the record on appeal is untimely filed and should be disregarded.

On July 22, 2026 the appellant filed a Motion to Strike the portions of the interlocutory appeal from Justice Toal that were not part of her decision making

process because they were not presented to the Court at the time of her ruling and other judges ruled on the case thereafter. Pursuant to SCACR Rule 240, the Respondent had **10 days after service** to oppose the Motion to Strike.¹ The Appellant avers the return is not timely even if an additional 5 days was added to deadline for the mailing of the Motion because at the latest with the 5 days added, the return would have been due on August 7, 2026. As such, the Appellant avers the Court should disregard the Respondent's return because it was almost 20 days too late with no motion to accept an untimely filing.

The Appellant respectfully references and incorporates her arguments as made in the Motion to Strike portions of the designation of matter and record for this case.

The Record for this case has been assembled, but not yet filed based on the Court's letter holding the appeal in abeyance pending the Court's decision on the Motion to Strike and the fact some transcripts are still outstanding along with the outstanding Petition for a Writ of Certiorari.
