1. On July 10, 2026, the Court issued a deficiency notice advising Appellant that her Initial Brief was not accompanied by a Designation of Matter and that, if she wished to request inclusion of the attachments filed with her Initial Brief in the Record on Appeal, she could list those materials in a designation pursuant to Rule 209, SCACR.
2. Appellant previously requested additional time to prepare and file the required Designation of Matter.
3. Appellant prepared the Designation of Matter in an effort to comply with the Court's deficiency notice and to specifically identify the materials she requests be included in the Record on Appeal.
4. The filing deadline passed before Appellant was able to complete and submit the Designation of Matter. The delay was brief and was not intended to delay these appellate proceedings.
5. Appellant is proceeding pro se and respectfully requests that the Court permit the late filing so that the appeal may be considered on the designated record.

6. Appellant is submitting the Designation of Matter with this Motion and respectfully requests that the Court accept it as filed.
7. Acceptance of the late-filed Designation of Matter would allow the appeal to proceed with the materials identified by Appellant and, to Appellant's knowledge, would not unfairly prejudice Respondent.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court excuse the brief delay, permit and accept the late filing of Appellant's Designation of Matter to Be Included in the Record on Appeal, deem the Designation filed as of the date it is received by the Court, and grant such other relief as the Court deems just and proper.
