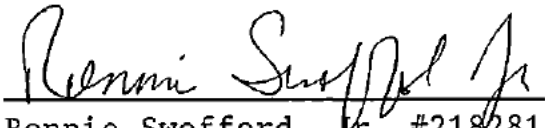
APPELLANT'S REPLY TO THE RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO REQUIRE

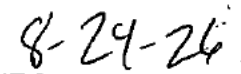

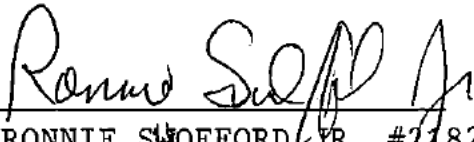

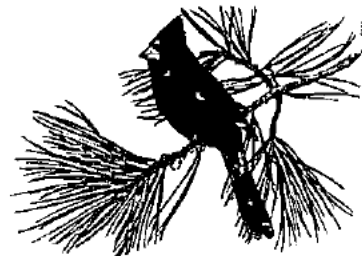
