JURISDICTION

Art 1, Sec 5 of the South Carolina Constitution and S.C. Code Ann § 14-3-310, "The Supreme Court shall have power to issue writs, or orders of ... Prohibition ... traditionally have been used by Appellate Courts to exert their revisory powers over inferior courts.

ARGUMENT

Petitioner feels as the Circuit Court exceeded its legitimate authority by ("prohibiting the petitioner from filing motions in the Clerk of Court") while the petitioner is an ~~Prose~~ defendant. Therefore there is no other adequate means by which he may represent himself. The facility where he is housed is inadequate to house prose defendants. The ONLY ONE outlet is to file motions. The jail allowed destruction of the petitioners discovery, see PACER: Reeves v. Roberts, C/A(26-3558), no Law library, no Legal materials, no access to a phone, no access to internet, no access to a photocopy, and the personell provided to help in Law - inadequate and ineffective, see PACER: Reeves v. Buford, C/A(26-2810). The tribunals ORDER is clearly erroneous as a matter of law and ~~is~~ is persistently a disregard for Substantive and procedural Law. This order is an often repeated account, see Attachment (5) and this seems to raise a new and important problem of Law of first impression.

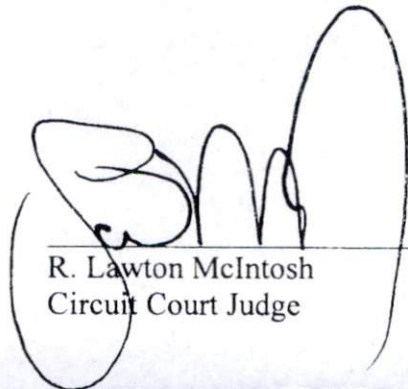

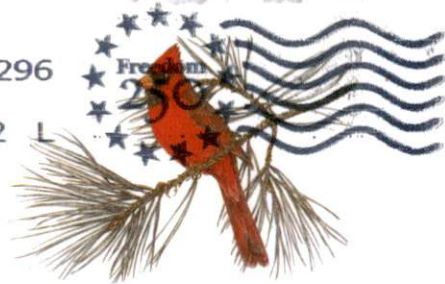
