**SECOND CORRECTED APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR PERMISSION TO SERVE
AND FILE
FINAL BRIEFS OUTSIDE THE FILING DEADLINE**

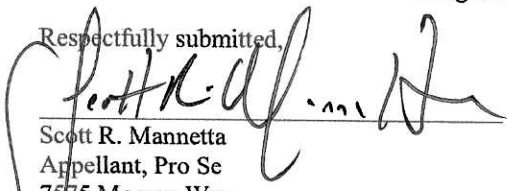
Appellant Scott R. Mannetta, appearing pro se, respectfully moves this Court for permission to serve and file his final briefs outside the filing deadline pursuant to Rule 211 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

In support of this Motion, Appellant respectfully states:

1. Appellant has actively prosecuted this appeal and previously filed and served his Initial Brief and subsequently filed his Reply Brief.
2. Appellant also prepared and filed the Record on Appeal and thereafter undertook substantial efforts to supplement the appellate record in response to issues concerning materials to be included in the record.
3. During that process, Appellant mistakenly understood that his previously filed Initial Brief and Reply Brief, together with his subsequent record filings, satisfied his remaining briefing obligations.
4. Appellant did not intentionally disregard a deadline or abandon this appeal. Rather, as a self-represented litigant, Appellant misunderstood the separate requirement under Rule 211 to serve and file final versions of his briefs following completion of the Record on Appeal.
5. Upon receiving the Court's August 10, 2026 correspondence advising Appellant that the time for serving and filing his final briefs had expired, Appellant acted promptly to correct the oversight.
6. On August 11, 2026, Appellant served the corrected motion, Appellant's Final Brief, and Appellant's Final Reply Brief upon Respondent's counsel by United States Certified First-Class Mail.
7. Appellant now submits this Second Corrected Motion and Proof of Service in response to the Court's September 2, 2026 deficiency letter and provides handwritten signature lines for both the Motion and Proof of Service.
8. Allowing the filing will permit this appeal to be resolved on its merits and will not unfairly prejudice Respondent, who has participated fully in the appellate proceedings and filed Respondent's Final Brief.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court grant permission to serve and file his final briefs outside the Rule 211 filing deadline and accept the accompanying briefs for filing.

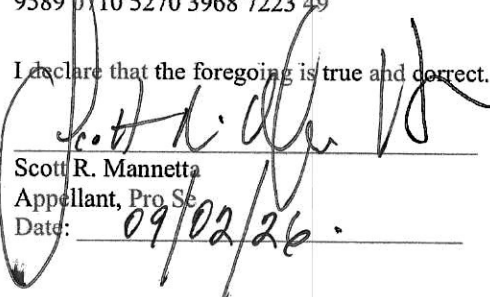
