Dear Court Staff:

I am Cornelius McClary, self-represented in my housing/eviction matter involving Southland/Vesco Properties.

I am providing this written notice to preserve the record of events occurring today, September 2, 2026. After my family left the residence, I was informed that individuals sent by Vesco/Southland were at the property and that our personal belongings, including household appliances, business property, storage materials, and other possessions, were placed outside. Vesco then contacted my wife and stated that we have 48 hours to collect our property from the ground.

Earlier, we had been actively attempting to obtain confirmation from the court concerning our emergency filings and whether any signed stay order had been entered. We also submitted documents by fax to the Summary Court today.

Please place this notice in the appropriate record and advise us only as to court status: whether any signed stay or other order affecting enforcement has been entered or filed. We are not asking court staff for legal advice.

We also respectfully request that this communication be preserved as a contemporaneous notice of the property-removal events and the 48-hour pickup statement made to my wife.
