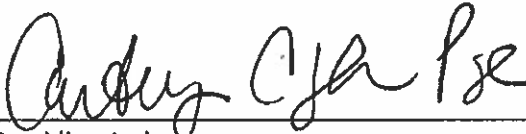
ORDER APPOINTING PUBLIC DEFENDER
