RETURN IN OPPOSITION TO RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

I, Camille Henderson, respectfully submit this Return in Opposition to Respondent Keith E. Fuller's Motion to Dismiss and ask that the Court deny the motion and allow this matter to proceed so that I may have a fair opportunity to present my case.

Respondent's motion contains allegations that are disputed. I respectfully deny that I have manipulated or abused the court system. I filed this matter in good faith because there are unresolved issues between the parties that I believe should be heard and decided through the proper legal process.

Respondent alleges that the City of Greenville issued a violation letter concerning the property at 205 Maco Terrace and attributes the alleged violation to me. However, the City of Greenville coding matter was dismissed. Therefore, that matter should not be used as a basis to dismiss my case or to prevent me from having my claims heard. A copy of the dismissal or closure documentation is attached as Exhibit B.

I also believe that Respondent has taken actions that have interfered with my ability to occupy and use the property. Specifically, Respondent contacted the power company and stated that he had not given permission for me to be in the house. As a result, an electric bill associated with a previous resident was placed on my record. That issue was later reversed, but it caused unnecessary difficulty and disruption. Documentation relating to the correction or reversal of the utility issue is attached as Exhibit C.

I also had to seek a restraining order/protective order against Respondent because he came to the residence and made threats toward me and individuals living at the property. The court granted that order. A true and correct copy of the granted protective/restraining order is attached as Exhibit A. This demonstrates that there are serious disputed issues between the parties that should be addressed through the proper court process rather than dismissed without allowing me an opportunity to be heard.

These events are relevant to the dispute between the parties, and I respectfully request the opportunity to present my documents, communications, lease-related information, utility records, the order granting protection, and any other evidence supporting my position.

I am not asking this Court to decide the disputed facts based on Respondent's motion alone. I am asking the Court to deny the request for dismissal so the matter may be resolved fairly and on its merits.

Request for Relief

For these reasons, I respectfully request that the Court:

1. Deny Respondent's Motion to Dismiss;
2. Allow this case to proceed according to the applicable rules and schedule;
3. Allow me a fair opportunity to present my evidence and be heard; and
4. Grant any further relief the Court finds proper.
