MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

Counsel for Terence Stukes respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from September 8, 2026, until October 8, 2026**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Terence Stukes respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of

extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

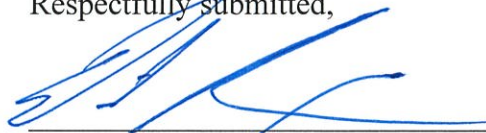

On August 24-25, 2026, counsel appeared in circuit court in Beaufort County representing a client who was called as a witness in the case of State v. Messiah Anderson. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Matthew Joseph Hogan with the Court of Appeals on August 19, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Eric Neal Patton v. The State with the Supreme Court on August 12, 2026. Counsel spoke at and attended a CLE on August 6-7, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Breonte A. Glasgow with the Court of Appeals on July 31, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Stacy Michelle Rabon with the Court of Appeals on July 30, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. James Etheridge Jones with the Court of Appeals on July 28, 2026.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. On August 27, 2026, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through October 1, 2026.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from September 8, 2026, until October 8, 2026**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances.

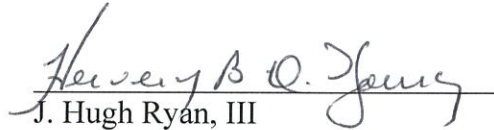
