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Dear Clerk of the South Carolina Court of Appeals:

I write to supplement my earlier email transmitted today in the above-captioned matter. Since sending that email, I have become aware that Master-in-Equity Alan D. Clemmons electronically signed and filed a Form 4 Order in the Horry County Court of Common Pleas this morning, September 8, 2026, in Case No. 2025-CP-26-00500.

I respectfully bring this filing to the Court's attention because it is directly relevant to the pending Renewed Emergency Petition for Writ of Supersedeas. In that Form 4, Master Clemmons states the following verbatim:

"To date, no Order regarding the Motion for Writ of Supersedeas has been entered."

This is the trial court's own confirmation, on the record as of September 7, 2026, that the proposed bond order communicated to the parties by email on August 20, 2026 has never been entered as a signed, filed order of the court. The Form 4 is attached to this email.
