This communication is to inform the Court that the transcript prepared by Legal Eagle is complete and awaiting final payment. I respectfully request until Thursday, September 17, the anniversary of the day my father was killed, 2026, to make the final payment.

I cannot safely ask for the money to make this final payment before Thursday. Asking for money for this case at this time places me in danger. I was physically beaten after it became known that Judge Hyman had validated the fraudulent loan based on Attorney William Lawson's unsupported claim that I said, "I wish he were dead," and portrayed Megan Burns as a victim based entirely on words I never said, while disregarding that I am the person who suffered actual harm...harm I would not wish upon anyone, including Megan Burns, along with other allegations for which Lawson produced no evidence. I am still recovering from that beating, and my face and neck remain swollen. I therefore respectfully request until Thursday, September 17, 2026, to make the final transcript payment.

Yes, I cannot pay the \$25.50 left to pay for the transcripts yet. Because of this loan I am kept in servitude and depravity until I can either clear this loan or repay the money to the Italians.
