My name is Daivion A. Beverly and I am writing to explain why I feel my case should be appealed. I was represented by a public defender who I don't feel represented or fought my case to the fullest for me. I'd explained early in my case that I wasn't read my rights at the time of my arrest nor after which he brushed off and never looked into just gave me a reason on why that wouldn't help me. I also was wrongfully blue lighted for a tint violation which was never mentioned during the stop and for a back tail light that was fully functioning. I asked my public defender to help me fight these points at trial which he constantly turned down telling me I had no fight. The drugs I caught the most time for I never admitted to nor knew were in my bag but he still wanted me to claim them and take time for them even after the passenger in my car tried to admit to them being hers.
