extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

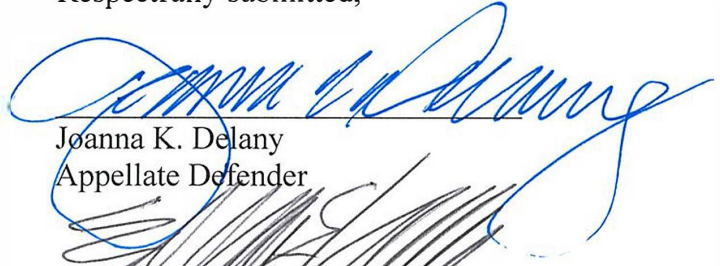

Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals and the Appendix in the case of The State v. Marcus Alexander Wigfall with the Supreme Court on August 14, 2026. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Michael Todd Roberts, Jr. with this Court on August 12, 2026. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Dontrell Henry Rufus with this Court on July 29, 2026.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

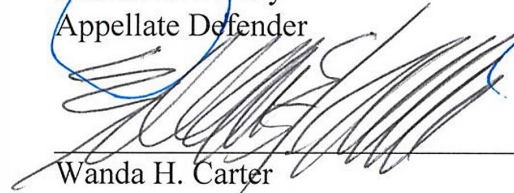
