previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

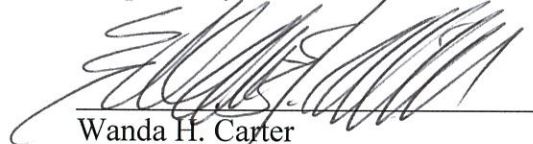

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Lawrence Brewer with the Court of Appeals on August 26, 2026. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Eric VanCleave with the Court of Appeals on August 26, 2026. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Clinton Beebe with the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals on August 20, 2026. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix and in the case of Montrelle Campbell v. State with the Supreme Court on August 19, 2026. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. William Camp with the Court of Appeals on July 27, 2026. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Apache Lawrence with the Court of Appeals on July 20, 2026. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Polo Salazar with the Court of Appeals on July 15, 2026.

4. On August 27, 2026, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy

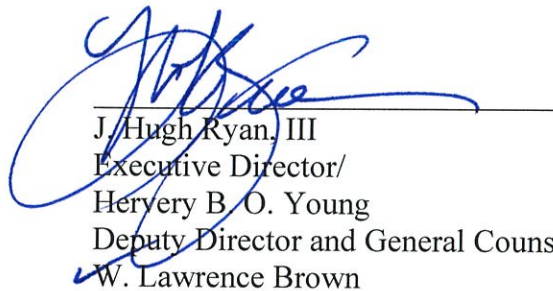
Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through October 1, 2026.
