JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO SERVE AND FILE FINAL BRIEFS

Appellant and Respondents hereby move pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR,  
for an extension until January 3, 2014, of the time in which to serve and file the  
parties' final briefs in this case. The grounds for this motion are that there is good  
cause to grant the requested extension, as the following shows:


1. The deadline for service and filing of the final briefs in this case is today, December 31, 2013.
2. In preparing to convert the Respondents' initial brief to the final brief, Respondents' counsel discovered two inadvertent omissions from the record on appeal, of which the parties' counsel had not previously been aware.


3. Respondents' counsel brought this to the attention of Appellants' counsel, and the parties agreed yesterday to resolve that discrepancy by supplementing the record on appeal. This supplementation is the subject of a separate joint motion submitted concurrently herewith.
4. While counsel quickly addressed the record discrepancy once it was discovered, the necessary delay caused by resolving this matter, on top of counsel's preexisting schedule, has prevented them from finishing the final briefs by the existing service and filing deadline.
5. As the extension sought is for three additional days during a holiday week, the parties believe that this extension will not prejudice the expeditious resolution of this case.
6. The parties' counsel believes there is good cause to grant the requested extension to January 3, 2014.

WHEREFORE Appellant and Respondents pray for an Order extending the time in which to serve and file the final briefs in this case to January 3, 2014.
