ORDER

Respondents filed a motion to dismiss, arguing the trial court's orders were not immediately appealable. After careful consideration, Respondents' motion is granted. *See Breland v. Love Chevrolet Olds, Inc.*, 330 S.C. 89, 93, 529 S.E.2d 11, 13 (2000) ("Currently, this Court does not allow immediate appellate review from the denial of any Rule 12(b), SCRCPP motion."); *Waddell v. Kahdy*, 309 S.C. 1, 4, 419 S.E.2d 783, 785 (1992) (noting an order compelling a party to submit to discovery is interlocutory and not immediately appealable).
