
I am of the belief that my creditors are well educated on my typical foreclosure generated bankruptcy and will seek to seize this appeal and the related appeal to recover their losses.

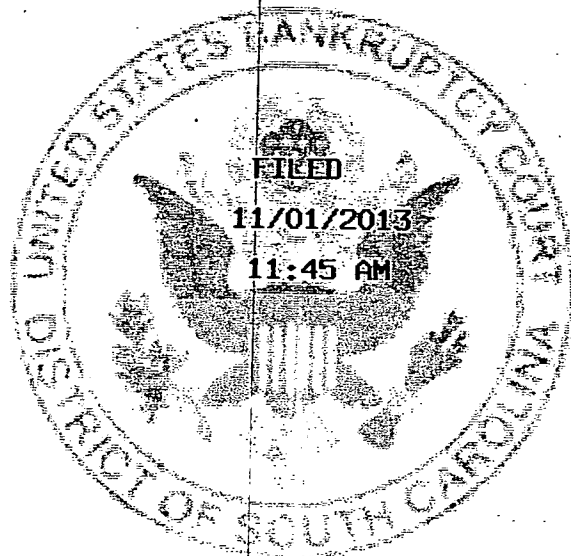
