Motion For Appointment of Counsel In All
Court of Appeals Cases Against S.C.D.C

The above Appellant would like to request a rare and possible unforeseen Motion For Appointment of Counsel. Appellant has numerous cases in this Honorable Court against S.C.D.C in which he is appealing the results of Disciplinary Hearings. He has exhausted his remedies through the S.C.D.C grievance process, and Administrative Law Court.

He now ask this Honorable Court to Appoint him Counsel, because S.C.D.C is intentionally denying him adequate access to the courts to fight these cases. These cases are very, very important because they have taken goodtime and this will change the calculation of his prison sentence.

Appellant has complained since he filed his 1st case in this court in 2009 or 2010, about adequate access being denied. But as of Dec. 2013 it has gotten outrages. First he hasn't been able to do any research on the computer, or lawbooks in over a month, even though he has constantly requested to Staff Members and General Counsel. Next they took weeks to allow him to go in his legal box to obtain info. and documents to pursue a Dec. 27th, 2013 Court deadline set by this Honorable Court. He has yet to meet this deadline, and has requested this court grant him an extension. The law library has had his copies that he needs for a Court of Appeals case for over two weeks.

The prison is now under an enforced isolation quarantine period and his legal mail has not been going out as needed. He is being issued limited amount of legal supplies. Further he has been receiving his mail and deadlines late as a result to this court and S.C.D.C. He has notified the Honorable Court of Appeals numerous times since Aug. 2013 that he is no longer at the Enoree S.C. Residents, he is now housed in Bishopville S.C. and they continue to send his mail to Enoree. The mailroom here is holding our legal mail for days and days, at a time.

It would be appropriate to appoint Appellant counsel, because he has cases with great merit, and a lawyer would assist him by hand delivering all motions and briefs to the Court of Appeals in a timely matter, and there will be no issue of inadequate access to the Courts.

Appellant ask his motion be granted, and he be appointed Counsel in all his Court of Appeals cases against S.C.D.C.

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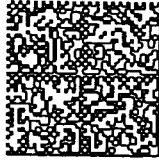

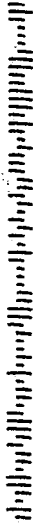
