**MOTION TO COMPEL PETITIONER TO SUPPLEMENT APPENDIX**

Pursuant to Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, counsel for Respondent moves for this Court to compel Petitioner to supplement the Appendix in this case. In support of this motion, Respondent would present the following facts:

1. Petitioner filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this matter on December 30, 2013.
2. Respondent's Return to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari is due on January 29, 2014.
3. In reviewing this case, Respondent notes the Appendix does not contain the

transcript of Petitioner's trial and conviction. This transcript was part of the record before the post-conviction relief judge and was referenced by the judge in his order denying post-conviction relief. Thus, Respondent must be able to reference it in the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari.

4. Inasmuch as the transcript is relevant and pertinent material under Rule 243(f), SCACR, that should be included in the Appendix, undersigned counsel for Respondent moves this Court to compel Petitioner to include the same in a Supplemental Appendix.

WHEREFORE, as the Appendix is incomplete, counsel for Respondent requests this Court: (1) grant the motion to compel Petitioner to supplement the Appendix and (2) hold time limits for the filing of the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari in abeyance until the motion is ruled upon.


