Dear Judge Cureton,

My home address in Landrum received your order dated 1-23-14 on 1-26-14 afternoon, relayed to me via text message as I am away for medical apptmts, long scheduled. I struggle to comply with all the directions and have been the only party to comply with brief deadlines of Sept. 3, 2013. Obviously, the form for the initial brief (primary debt issue abandoned in Sept. '13 by Blue Ridge) did not meet specifications and though I requested relaxing of strict rules, have been refused. I should note that despite seeking paid assistance from 7+ lawyers, have been refused as none want to deal with the rules, I am advised. This experience, though we prevailed in a 3-day jury trial against overwhelming odds but as Complainants lacked the facts, has been our near-worst expensive nightmare. I cannot address another redo of Initial Brief for several weeks as in medical surgical procedures in Charleston and with no computer. I will struggle again to comply but request at least a 2-3 week extension as I am under medical procedures and care for at least that long having just gotten my husband back to limited work with his own medical issues. We certainly do not deserve dismissal for the facts, the case verdict from an impartial jury and justice remains on our side. I can't imagine a Court of Justice would dismiss truth much less when I extended best efforts to deliver the truth in transcripts the other side told you didn't exist. I try and feel unjustly targeted.

Thank you for a deserved continuance. A medical statement (1 of many) is attached as confirmation. We have had minimum of 3 days shut-down from weather here in Charleston where my Dr.'s.

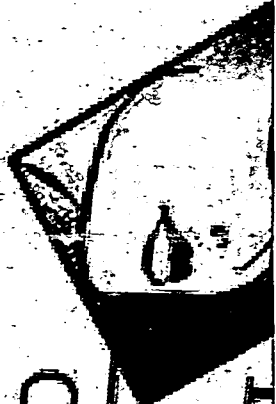
