



This dismissal, however, shall not preclude P & A or any individual Plaintiff from raising, in subsequent administrative appeals involving specific individuals, the issues discussed in § 3(b) of the Order, pp. 16-18, so long as such subsequent appeals involve matters that could not have been raised in the present case."

In all other respects, this Court is unable to discover any material fact or principle of law that either has been overlooked or disregarded and further finds no error of law or facts not appropriately considered. Accordingly, this Court hereby **DENIES** Plaintiffs' Motion under to Rule 59(e), SCRPC to Reconsider this Court's Order filed September 24, 2013.
