
The ground for this Motion is that the parties have reached a settlement in principle. The general terms of the settlement have been reduced to writing pursuant to Rule 43(k), SCRCP, and signed by all parties save one. The parties are in the process of finalizing all necessary settlement documents and seeking court approval on a proposed

Second Consent Order for Permanent Injunction. The Respondents have provided draft settlement documents to the Appellants for review and are now awaiting the Appellants' feedback. With consent of Appellants' counsel John Esposito, the Respondents are now requesting an extension of 60 days from today because of the time necessary to complete negotiations as to the settlement documents, for eight parties to execute settlement documents, and to obtain approval from the Circuit Court for such settlement.

This Motion is not made for purposes of undue delay or any other improper purpose.

THEREFORE, with consent of the Appellants, the Respondents request an Order extending the time to file the Initial Brief of Respondents and Designation of Matter for sixty (60) days from the date of such Order and request that all time lines be held in abeyance until further Order of this Court.



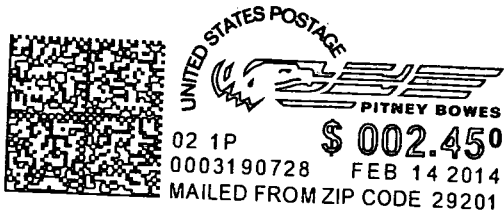
