

ADDENDUM TO NOTICE OF APPEAL – GROUNDS FOR APPEAL

Appellant appeals on the following grounds, together with any other grounds appropriate under the applicable case, statutory and regulatory law.

The Circuit Court erred in failing to grant Appellants Rule 59(e) motion for Reconsideration and in failing to hear the matter on its merits inasmuch as:

- I. JURISDICTION IS PROPER IN THE CIRCUIT COURT PURSUANT TO CASE AND STATUTORY LAW APPLICABLE TO PRE-JULY 1, 2007 WORKERS' COMPENSATION CASES.**
- II. INCLUSION OF ANY ALTERNATE OR ADDITION GROUNDS FOR DISMISSAL OF THE APPEAL ON THE GROUNDS OF FAILURE TO PROSECUTE WAS INAPPROPRIATE IN LIGHT OF THE COURT'S INDICATION AT THE HEARING ON THIS MATTER THAT MATTERS ASIDE FROM JURISDICTIONAL CONCERNS WOULD BE HELD IN ABEYANCE IN ORDER TO ALLOW THE COURT ADEQUATE TIME TO FULLY CONSIDER THE PARTIES' ARGUMENTS REGARDING SUBJECT MATTER JURISDICTION.**
- III. DISMISSAL OF THE APPEAL FOR FAILURE TO PROSECUTE AND/OR PERFECT THE APPEAL AMOUNTS TO AN ABUSE OF DISCRETION.**



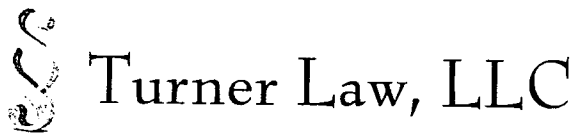
