

**ORDER DENYING APPLICANT'S RULE 59(e)  
MOTION TO ALTER OR AMEND THE  
JUDGMENT**


This matter comes before the Court by way of Applicant's Rule 59(e) Motion to Alter or Amend the Judgment filed January 21, 2014. The Order of Dismissal in this matter was signed by me on December 27, 2013.

After due deliberation and careful reconsideration of all of the evidence, memoranda, case law, and documents submitted in this case and upon full consideration of Applicant's motion, this Court is not persuaded to alter or amend the judgment. In the motion, Applicant reiterates arguments made in his application, at the evidentiary hearing, and in his motion to file a second amended application. This Court, having addressed these issues repeatedly, sees no reason to depart from its earlier ruling.
