
The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth, and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

That on February 3rd 2009, while at the dead end of Hitching Post Rd., in the Charleston section of the County and State aforesaid, the above named defendant did violate section 44-53-370, "Trafficking Cocaine". The defendant did willfully and unlawfully distribute a quantity of white powdery substance to a confidential informant. The white powdery substance material had a total approximate weight of more 10 grams and field-tested presumptive for cocaine. The confidential informant was searched prior to and after the controlled purchase. The purchase occurred under controlled conditions using prerecorded Metro currency, audio and video recording devices.

The above is true and believable, based on the personal observations and investigations of Detectives A. Miller, M. Brown and S.C. Perkins who are witnesses to prove the same in such case made and provided against the peace and dignity of the State of South Carolina.
