
THIRD MOTION TO SERVE AND FILE
APPELLANT'S INITIAL BRIEF OUT OF TIME

The undersigned moves to Serve and File Appellant's Initial Brief out of time. The first motion was actually for an extension by consent (not a motion to file out of time), requesting additional time to attempt to settle after a related order was issued by the DHHS hearing officer.


