MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

On January 8, 2014, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Perry Keith Strickland v. State with this Court. On December 27, 2013, counsel filed a brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. James Hagan with the Court of Appeals. On December 20, 2013, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Efrain Thomas v. State with this Court.



WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final extension of five (5) business days until February 28, 2014**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari


and appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. **Counsel will make every effort to file this petition before February 28, 2014.**
