MOTION TO EXTEND TIME FOR SERVICE  
OF RECORD ON APPEAL

COMES NOW Appellant, by Counsel, and hereby Moves this Court to Extend Time for Service of Record on Appeal, stating as follows:

Counsel was served with Respondent's Initial Brief on/about January 4, 2014. Counsel elected not to file a Reply Brief, and therefore did not do so. Counsel received the Court's letter dated January 10, 2014, setting forth the mechanical guidelines for filing additional briefs and record on appeal.

On February 6, 2014, Counsel spoke with Mr. Brandt, Counsel for Respondent, who was advised that the case was "under review," that the filing of the Record on Appeal was overdue, and that he would not object to an extension to accomplish the same.

After said conversation, and a discussion of our mutual understanding of the Rules, Counsel immediately recognized his mistake. Under Rule 210(a), the Record on Appeal is to be served "(w)ithin thirty (30) days after service of the last brief." Due to mistake and misunderstanding, Counsel erroneously calendared the time for serving the record on appeal thirty days past the February, 2014, due date for the Reply Brief.


