Dear Counsel:

This Court received your document entitled "Notice of Appeal" dated February 7, 2014, and filed with the Supreme Court. This appeal was transferred to the Court of Appeals for disposition. Accordingly, all future filings in this case should be addressed to the Court of Appeals.

Furthermore, this document purports to be an appeal from a post-conviction relief proceeding; however, the General Sessions case number on the new notice of appeal is the same as the case number in Mr. Snipes' direct appeal, which is currently pending at the Court of Appeals under appellate case number 2013-001651. In that appeal, the Court has requested that you provide proof of ordering the transcript on three different occasions. See the letters from this Court dated September 4, 2013; October 21, 2013; and December 11, 2013. Because you have finally included proof of having ordered the transcript, we will accept the letter included with this new filing as moving the pending direct appeal forward.

Please be aware that your letter requesting the transcript is deficient, in that it does not include a satisfactory arrangement in writing with the court reporter regarding payment for the transcript. *See* Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR ("Where a transcript of the proceeding must be prepared by the court reporter, appellant shall, within the time provided for ordering the transcript, make satisfactory arrangements (including agreement regarding payment for the transcript), in writing with the court reporter for furnishing the transcript."). You must correct this deficiency by making satisfactory arrangements with the court reporter within ten days of the date of this letter or risk further adverse action by the Court.

We are returning your document dated February 7, 2014, and entitled "Notice of Appeal" to you, as a notice of appeal of this direct appeal has already been filed and is currently pending. We await a copy of the corrected correspondence showing a satisfactory arrangement of payment to the court reporter within ten days.
