

ORDER

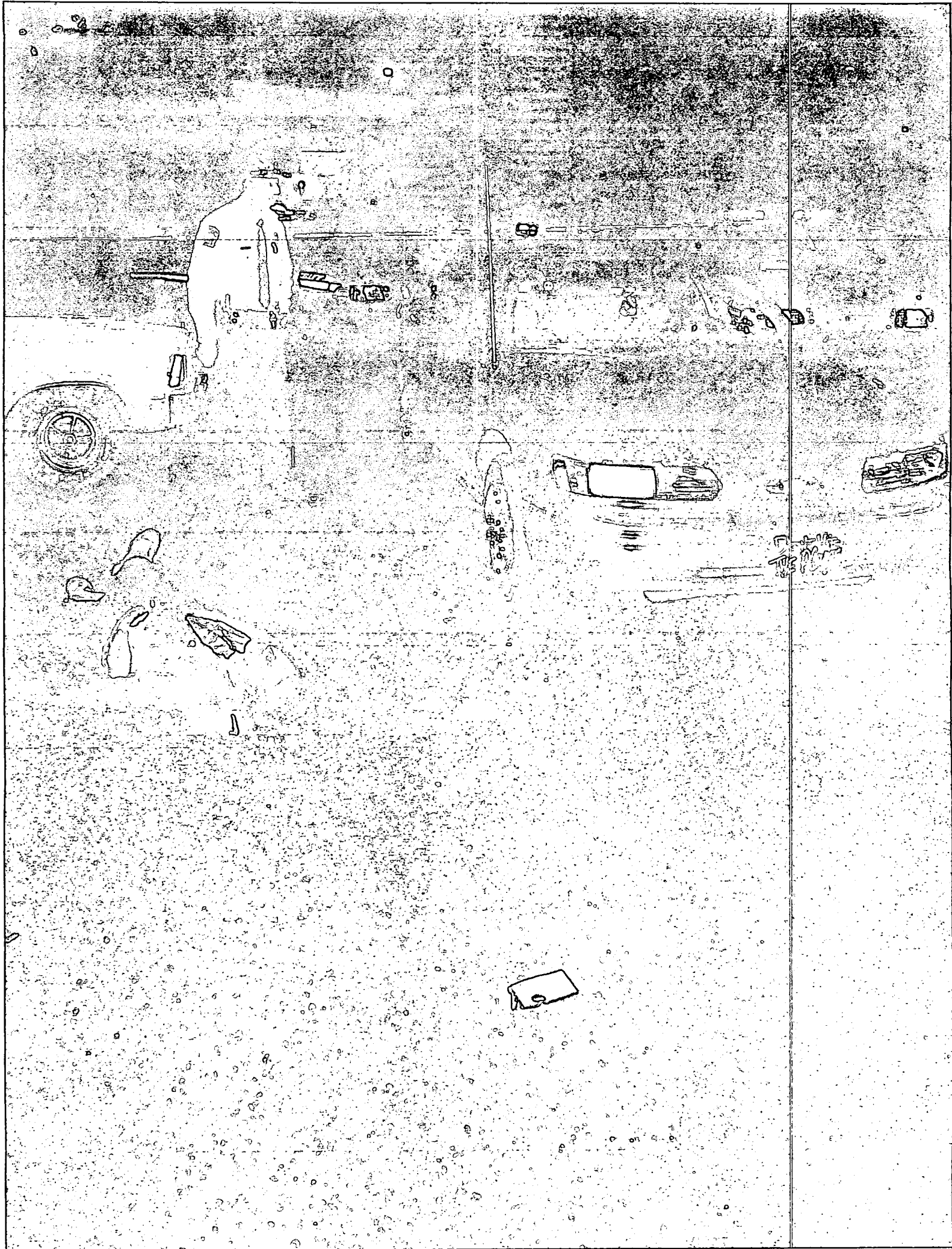

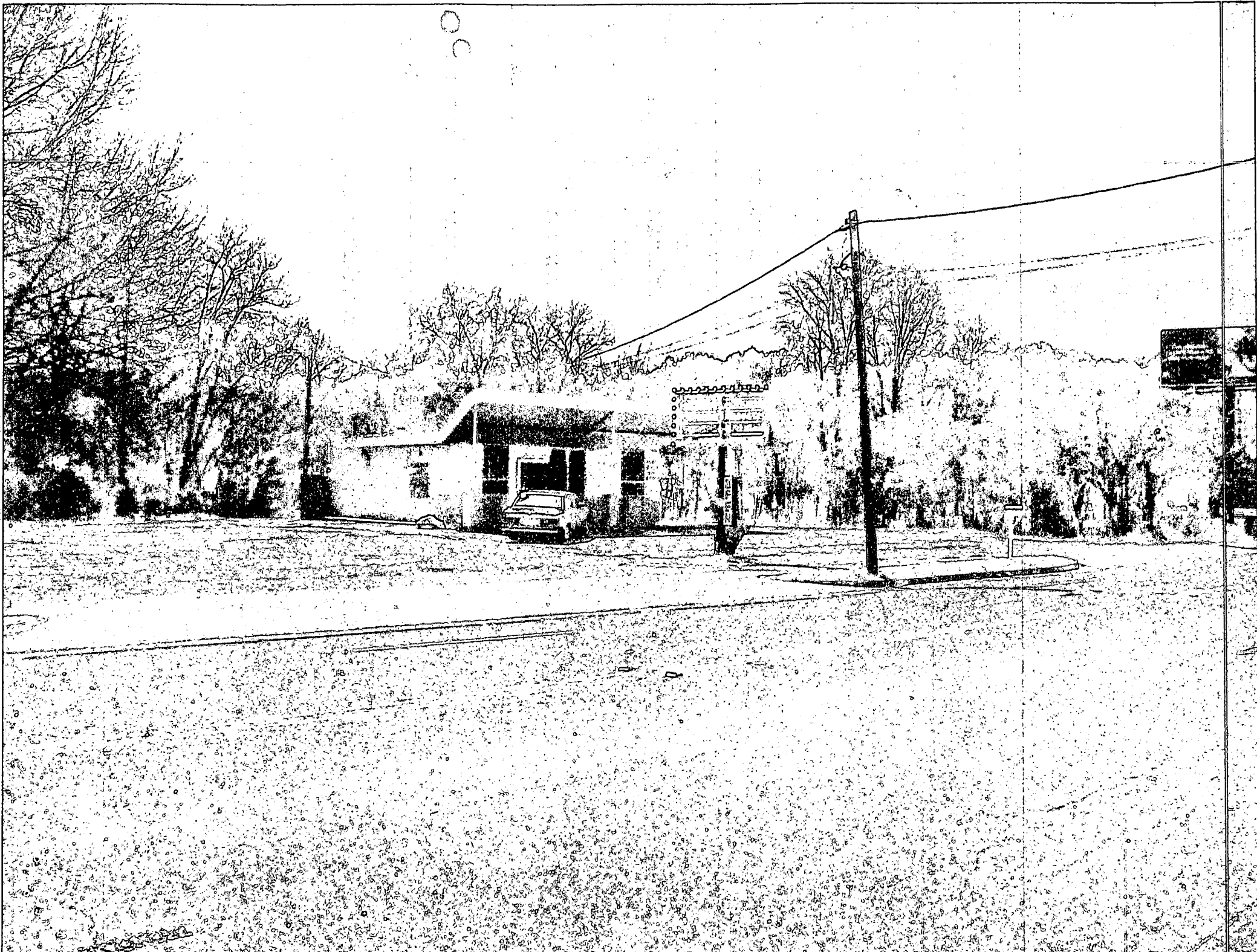
