In December 2012 my Appellate attorney filed a writ of cert: to the Supreme Court. I've been incarcerated since February 2011. This is my complaint and I'm wondering will you help me. On the Search Warrant The Police obtained to enter my home Law Enforcement stated that within the past 72 hrs a reliable confidential informant purchased a quantity of crack cocaine from my home and the event was monitored by law enforcement agents. On May 18, 2008 Darlington County Law Enforcement

conducted a drug transaction allegedly at a house on the street I lived on. On May 21, 2008 they performed an illegal search on my residence. During the jury trial which is stated in the trial transcript, On pg 186-187 Lt. George Wilkes stated that he was in charge of corralling the whole search and the purpose of the search was for a guy named Darenzo Graham and that he knew in fact Darenzo lived down the road from me. On pg 137 Ofc. William Baird stated from being at my home on previous accounts they went to the right door because they felt I had a gun didn't wanna breach on top of me. On pg 150 Chad McInville stated that the alleged distributor Darenzo Graham lived down the street from Marcus I would say several 100 yards. On pg 75 the solicitor stated you can't see the person good nor did they search him after the transaction. Brad Lawson the officer that obtained the search Warrant on pg 55 stated the C.I. was at least 15 yards away from my home.

during the drug transaction nor did he see him
in my house My name or my address wasn't
referenced either Ofc. Wright whom monitored
the drug buy also stated the C.I. didn't enter
my home or go on my property nor was I on the
Video. The Video was never viewed during the trial
or the suppression hearing for the jury to see. I
have never seen the video til this day. My Lawyer
Will Grove said the C.I. called the drug dealer
and set up the transaction prior to the buy
which was also never revealed during the trial
The Judge said he would look at the video but
wouldn't allow me, the right. I've been paralyzed
since 2003 It was verified during trial by the
policemen me nor my home were any part of
the drug buy the judge policemen and solicitor
stated you cant see the person in the video good
So why and how did they receive a search
warrant to enter my home when the drug
buy didnt have anything to do with me
which is a violation of My fourth ~~Amendment~~

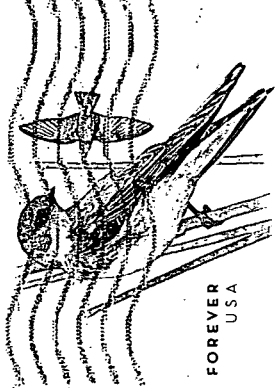
The police lied to the Magistrate Judge to obtain the Search Warrant. Both Officers stated I wasn't mentioned during any part of the drug transaction the C.I. never seen me, Also Will Grove said the C.I. girlfriend call the drug dealer phone and set up the drug deal. No one ever said Marcus Addison. They admitted they couldn't identify the drug dealer but at the same time stated it could've been one or two people but not Marcus Addison, and why wasn't one of the two served a warrant. I'm pretty sure the C.I. knew who phone number they were calling before they decided to purchase drugs. I don't think it was a random number do you.

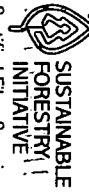
