
ORDER

This case was dismissed on September 16, 2013, for failure to cure the deficiencies in filing the notice of appeal. However, the Court received a notice of appeal from the appellant on September 6, 2013, which contained all necessary documents to cure the deficiencies in this appeal. We treated the new notice of appeal as a new case and assigned it appellate case number 2013-001894. The new notice of appeal was also dismissed on November 8, 2013, as being untimely filed.

We consolidate these two appeals and issue this order amending the orders of dismissal for failure to cure deficiencies and failure to timely file a notice of appeal. Rather than dismissing on those grounds, the Court finds it is appropriate to dismiss this consolidated appeal for the failure to provide a sufficient guilty plea explanation as required by Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iv) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). Accordingly, the consolidated appeal is dismissed. Remittitur will be sent pursuant to Rule 221(b), SCACR. The time to file a petition for rehearing will be calculated beginning with the date of this order.
