For the above reasons, the undersigned requests this extension.



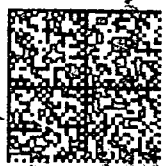
